How It Works

We recruit and screen all applicants via our rigorous application process. We then make matching recommendations based on your job description(s) and support the hiring process.


We host trainings to prepare interns for their first day at work. While interning, interns participate in a college and career readiness curriculum & workshops through our partnership with LA Trade Tech College to ensure their placement is successful. All interns receive college credit!

Jan-March

TIP Applications open for students



April-May

LA Promise Fund vets and matches students for host companies to interview and select interns



June-August

Internships and students programming take place, including career readiness workshops and corporate engagement opportunities

The Investment

60 paid hours minimum plus program investment cost \$350 per placement. Paid hours are determined by \$16/hour X number of hours per student.


